

## Profiling the noise

Use this form to document a profile of your noise, providing you with a solid analysis on which to identify and resolve your noise.

Follow the process and consider the following characteristics of your noise problem/s.

Noise Characteristic	Comments
Have you ruled out noise sources inside your property? Confirm how you've done this.	
What times of the day is the noise occurring? What days of the week?	
Are you able to suggest any likely sources that may have a causal relationship?	
Is the noise originating from a particular direction?

Are you able to link the noise in with any domestic or recreational routines in the household that may indicate the source of the noise?	
Is the noise broadband or centred on particular frequencies?	
Are you able to identify a range of frequencies the noise centres on? (highest and lowest frequencies)	
Do you have images from a spectrum scope and audio recordings of the noise? These are often very useful in profiling and determining the nature of the noise.	
Have you undertaken any direction- finding activities to assist in identifying the source of the noise?
